

DOOR GLASS CHANNELS Triumph TR4-50 & TR6



Part Number: 812436, 812437, 850430 & 850431

The enclosed window channels have been reproduced to the specifications found on the factory drawings. As you install your new channels you will notice that there are a variety of adjustments that can be made. These adjustments allow you to align the door glass, and they allow you to regulate the tightness of the glass channels. Our research has shown that a washer (part number GHF314) was often fitted between the mounting brackets on the channels and the inside of the door shell. This washer was used to shim the brackets closer together. There was apparently variation from one door to another as some doors had this washer fitted while others did not.

With each door channel we are supplying a number of washers (part no. GHF314). These washers are the same diameter, but they are half the thickness. This will allow for greater flexibility when fitting the new channels. By using these washers as shims, and by taking advantage of the adjustability designed into the mounting of these channels, you should be able to install your window channels with the correct tension on the glass.
